

CITY OF THORNTON – NOVEMBER 23, 2009 – 6:00 P.M. – CITY HALL

The Thornton City Council met in special session on the above date and time with Mayor Phillip McLaughlin calling the meeting to order. Council members present: Barbara Hopkey, Larry Stadlander, Barry Groh, and Joy Baker. Absent: Michael Younge. Hopkey made a motion to approve the agenda. Baker seconded, motion carried.

Pam Wonsmos reported that the real estate listing for the City lot located at the intersection of 4th Street and Willow Street expires on November 26, 2009. After discussion, Baker made a motion to extend the listing for another 6 months with Property Link & Jaspersen Insurance & Real Estate. Groh seconded, motion carried.

Hopkey made a motion to adopt by Resolution the sale of the property to Bruce & Melanie Smit and Shelby & Alana Steenhard. Groh seconded, motion carried, therefore Resolution # 09-11 adopted.
